What are the five most important steps in constructing a Whānau Profile?

1. Establish a relationship – Building trust and loyalty by rapport- Whanaungatanga – Powhiri principles – Manaakitanga establishing a kawa - -just korero- no paper work initially- establishing a joint initiative- ask whānau how they would like to construct profile- maybe in a creative way of demonstrating their profile- example video, music etc.

2. Purpose to be defined by and with whānau -Manaakitanga

Be aware a lot of whānau are blended 'internationally' very important to get to know the whānau composition

3. Establish agreement

4. Whānau aspirations – what do they want (The collaborative plan)

5. Moving along – what's the next step
